MEMORANDUM FOR WIESBADEN CONTRACTING OFFICE

SUBJECT: Sole Source Justification for Fragmentation Retention Film (FRF)

1. The following pertains to fragmentation retention film (FRF) for all identified facilities in the 221st Base Support Battalion. The FRF requirements for this community are as follows. FRF must be a minimum of 15mil thick/375 micron and have applied sun control qualities applied with-in the FRF, scratch-resistant and passed Underwriter Laboratories and Security glazing test 972 and A1/DIN test 52290, EN 356 p2 test, European specifications.

2. The following company has been identified as the only company in the federal republic of Germany with the technology to manufacture the type of fragmentation retention film UL972 and (FRF) with applied sun control qualities that meet U.S. specifications as required for security reasons in the 221st Base Support Battalion AOR. The FRF required for application in this community is identified as:

a. PROFILON AXA1 15 mil/375 micron SR multi-laminate with DURITAL scratch-resistant Surface, class UL 972 and A1/DIN 52290-EN 356 P2.

b. PROFILON AX A1 SR 15 mil/375 micron SR solar 20 silver 20R multi-laminate with DURITAL scratch-resistant surface, class UL 972 and A1/DIN 52290-EN 356 P2

3. When other contractors have been awarded FRF jobs they have turned to Haverkamp for materials and technical expertise to complete the job possibly causing a lower number of windows being completed.
